A respectful silence fell over the Clergy Conference as the assembly received the news of the death of **Father Bernard Michael 'Mick' Fitzpatrick PE**, who died yesterday, 28 June 2016 at St John of God Hospital, Geelong, surrounded by the prayers of the Church entrusting him to the God he served with such fidelity and devotion. Fr Mick was aged 83 years and served as a priest of the Archdiocese of Melbourne for 57 years.

Ordained a priest at St Mary's Church, Castlemaine on 27 July 1958, Fr Mick served as Chaplain to the Orphanages in Geelong and Assistant Priest of Geelong and Camberwell parishes before being appointed Director of Vocations. He held various Archdiocesan appointments and was the inaugural Director of the Ministry to Priests programme. He was appointed Parish Priest of Belmont. He spent time at Macleod parish before being Parish Priest of West Geelong and then Administrator at Geelong Parish. He served at Bell Park Parish (Geelong Cluster) and was appointed *Pastor Emeritus* in 2015.

Fr Mick was hewn from the rocks of Maldon and was formed in the Catholic faith of the Fitzpatrick family. He was a thoroughly Christian man whose love of Jesus was evident in his preaching, pastoral care and accompaniment of others in search of Jesus the Good Shepherd.

Among the presbyterate Fr Mick will be remembered for his accompaniment of men discerning their vocation and his support of his brother priests who found in him a fellow pilgrim of wise counsel and a generous friend. While Fr Mick never formally 'retired', he will always be remembered across the parishes of the Archdiocese and, in particular, the Geelong Cluster. We acknowledge the pastoral friendship between Fr Mick and Fr Gerard Keith and all who have prayed for him in these recent weeks. May he rest in peace and rise in Glory.
