PARISH LEADERSHIP TEAM MEETING

Last Tuesday a productive meeting was held on addressing two questions -

What can we do to honour Fr Mick's memory and legacy?

- Holy Spirit School will name a new Meeting Room in honour of Fr Mick.
- Each school will have a Scholarship established to recognise students outstanding in Social Service, Justice and Faith, etc and this will be paid out of the Parish School Levy The name will be *Fr Mick's Scholarship*
- St Pat's will name its fund that assists disadvantaged families after Fr Mick Fr Mick's Family Support Fund
- People were receptive to the idea of a Memorial Garden but a couple of questions need to be addressed where the garden(s) would be located and ongoing maintenance. A committee to be established to further investigate the practicalities of a Memorial Garden.
- Placing plaques on Church furnishings with the name of Fr Mick, eg the Holy Water Font, Narthex, Priest's Presidential Chair, Lectern/ Pulpit
- The Meeting Room at the Pastoral Cluster Centre be named after Fr Mick
- A photo/painted portrait be commissioned of Fr Mick and placed in a prominent position
- Seating benches be purchased with a plaque to Fr Mick and situated in the passive play areas of the schools; similar benches to be placed in Church surrounds.
- An ongoing conversation is how we could encourage parishioners to better mingle and talk after Mass.
- Each of the schools either have or will have a Memorial Service for Fr Mick.

How do we work towards the Pastoral Cluster having one Priest?

• At this stage the conversation is ongoing, but a letter will be drafted soon and presented to parishioners with the focus that we need to rationalise both in the administration and structures as well as the Mass times.
